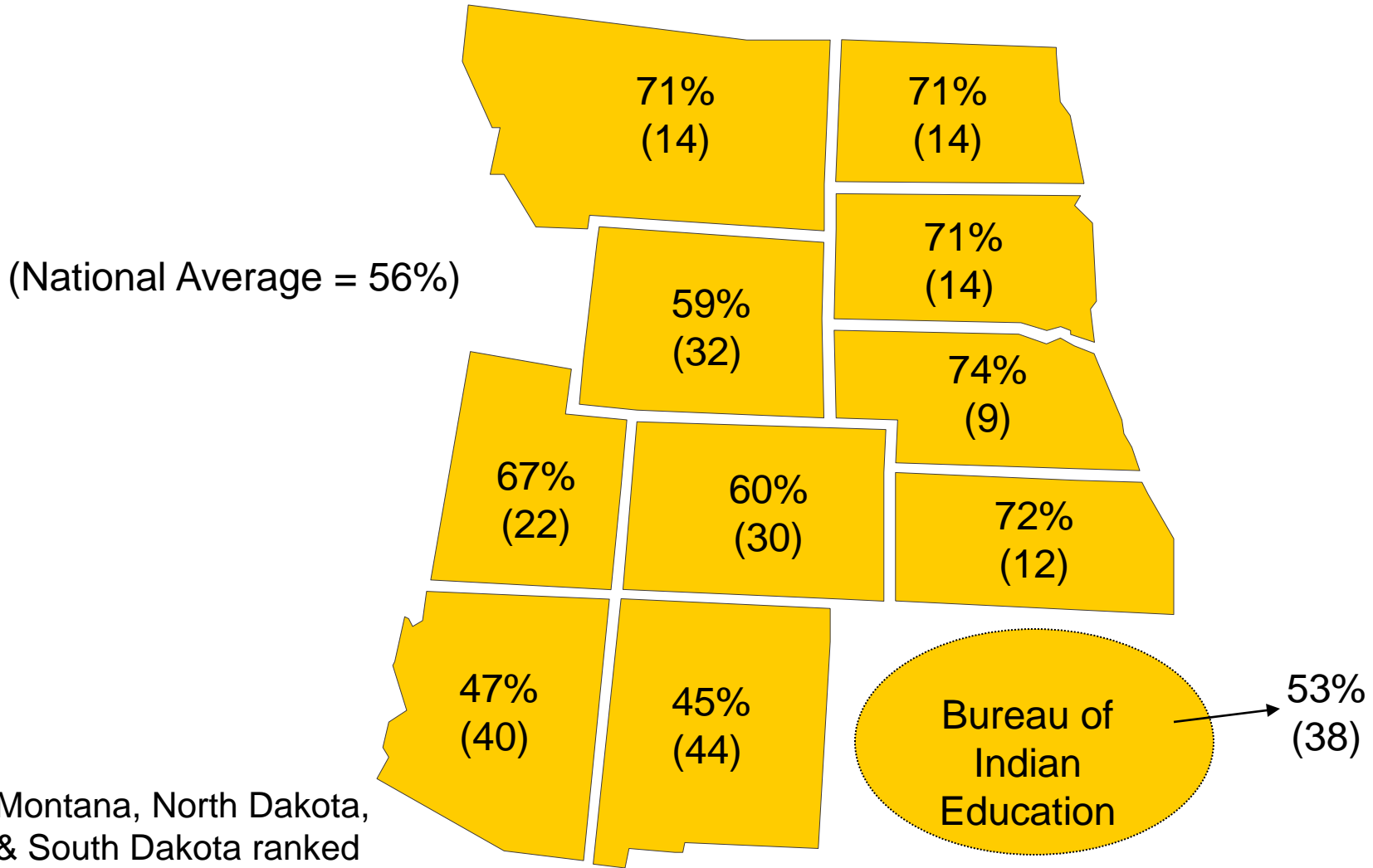

## Students with Disabilities Ages 14-21 Exiting



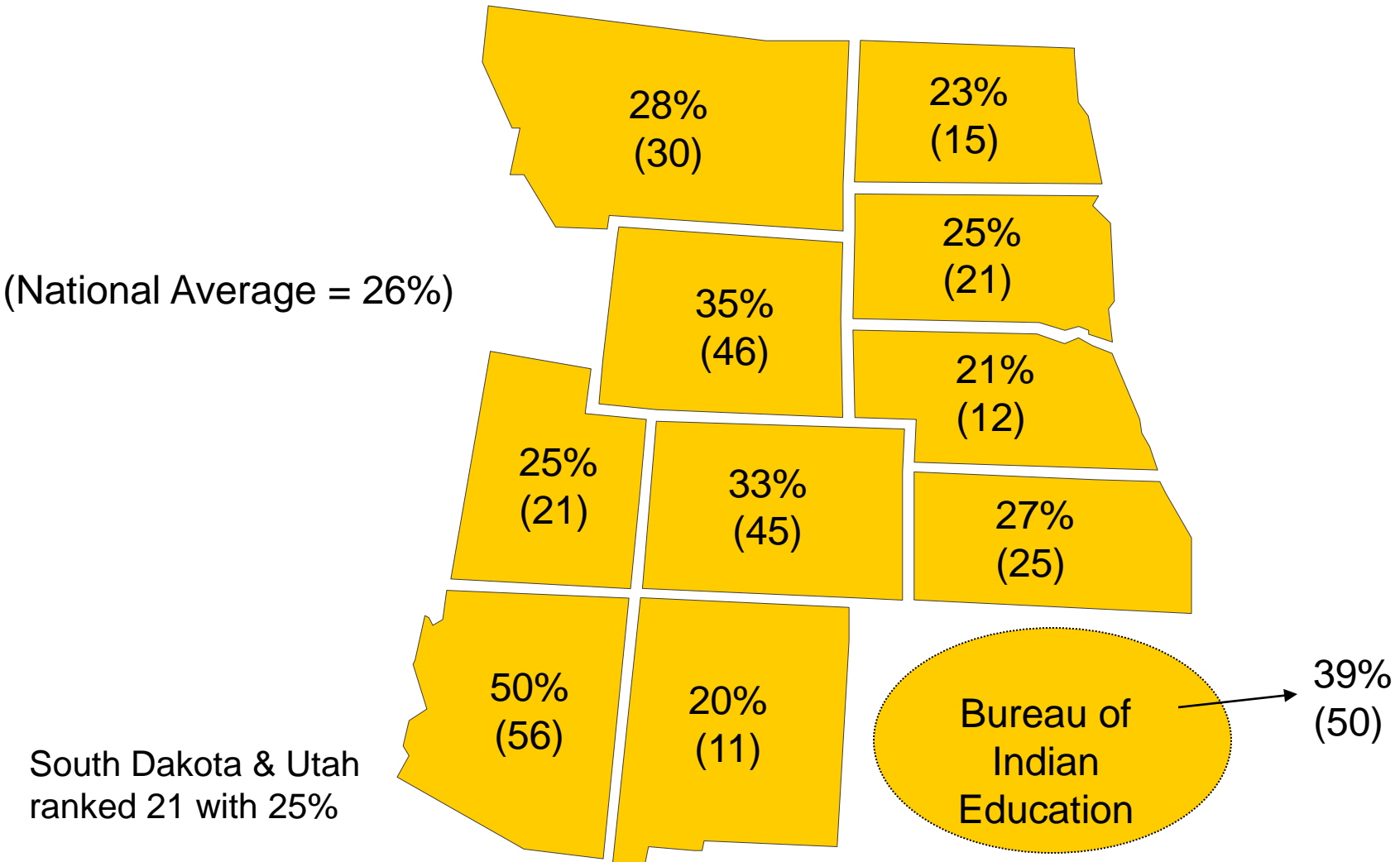

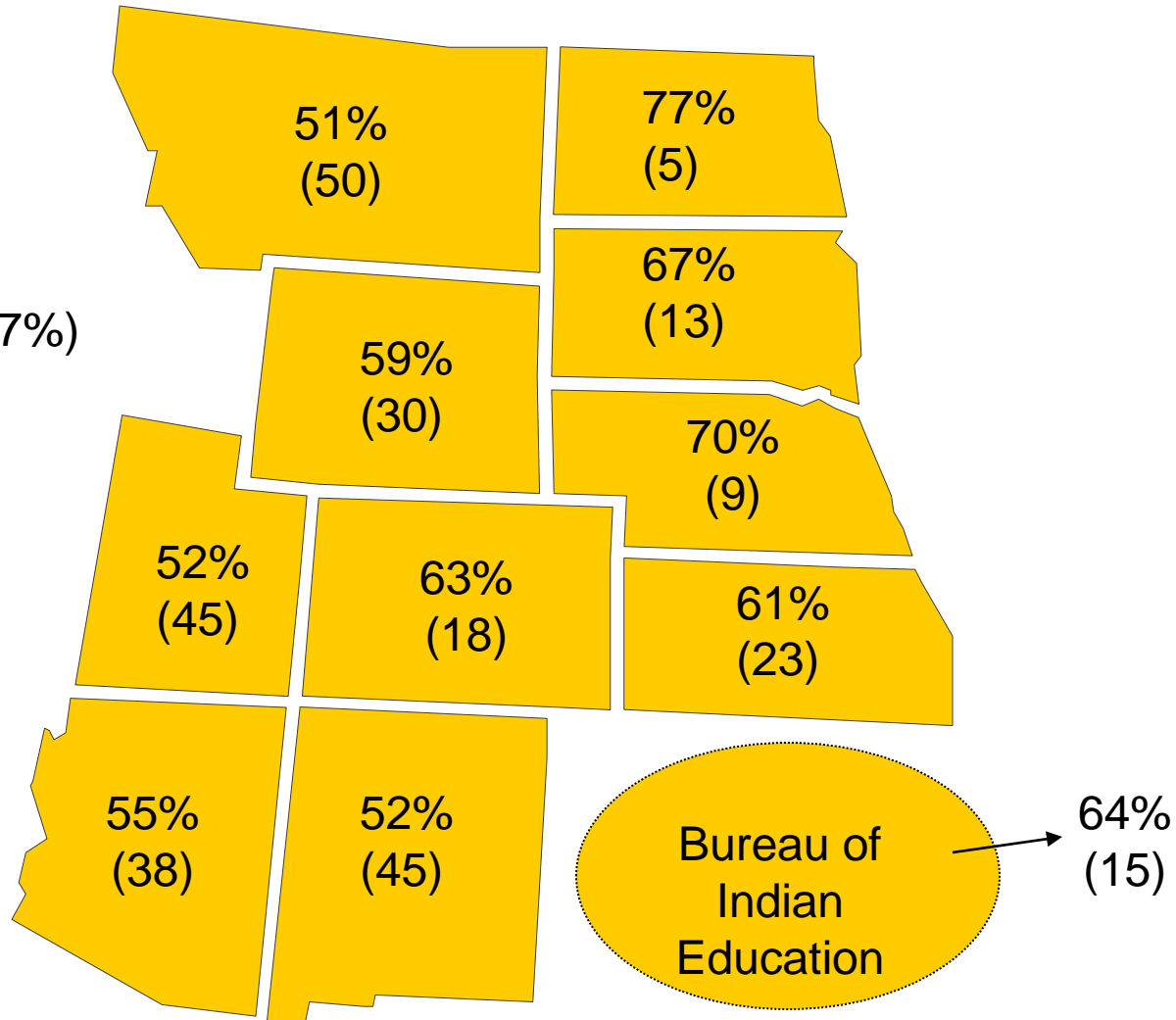
## Students with Disabilities Ages 14-21 Exiting

(National Average = 57%)

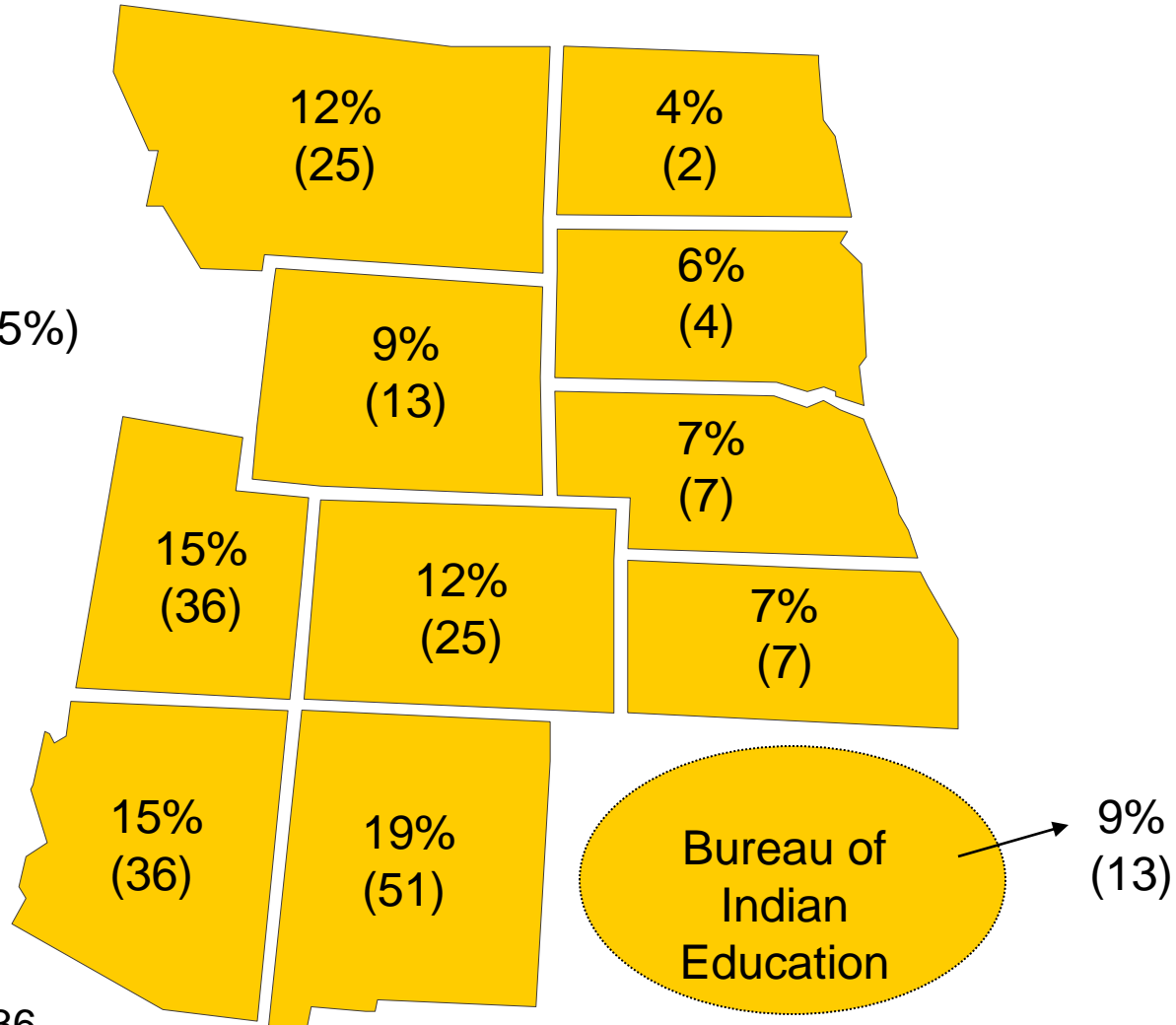

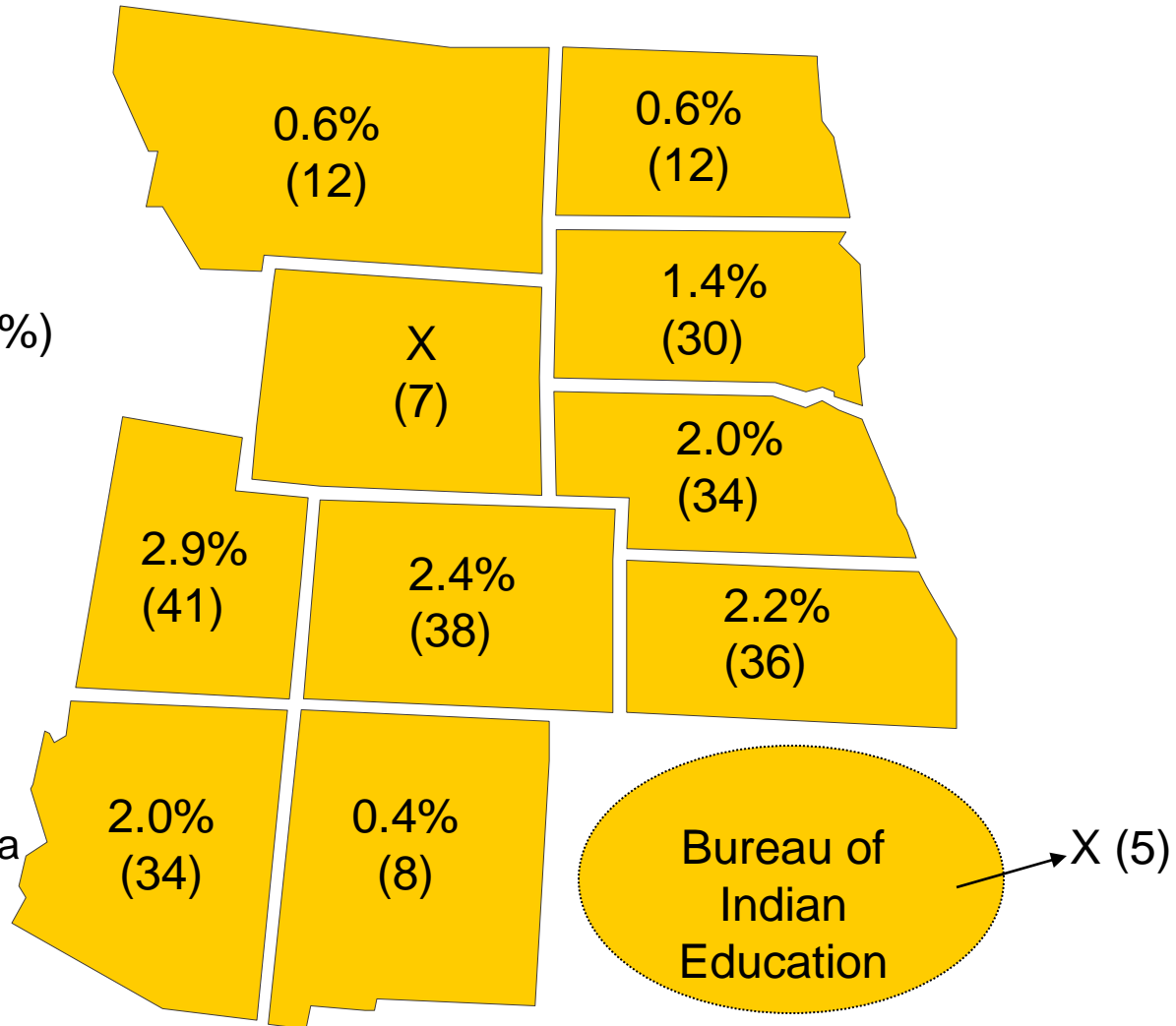

Montana & North Dakota ranked 12 with 0.6%

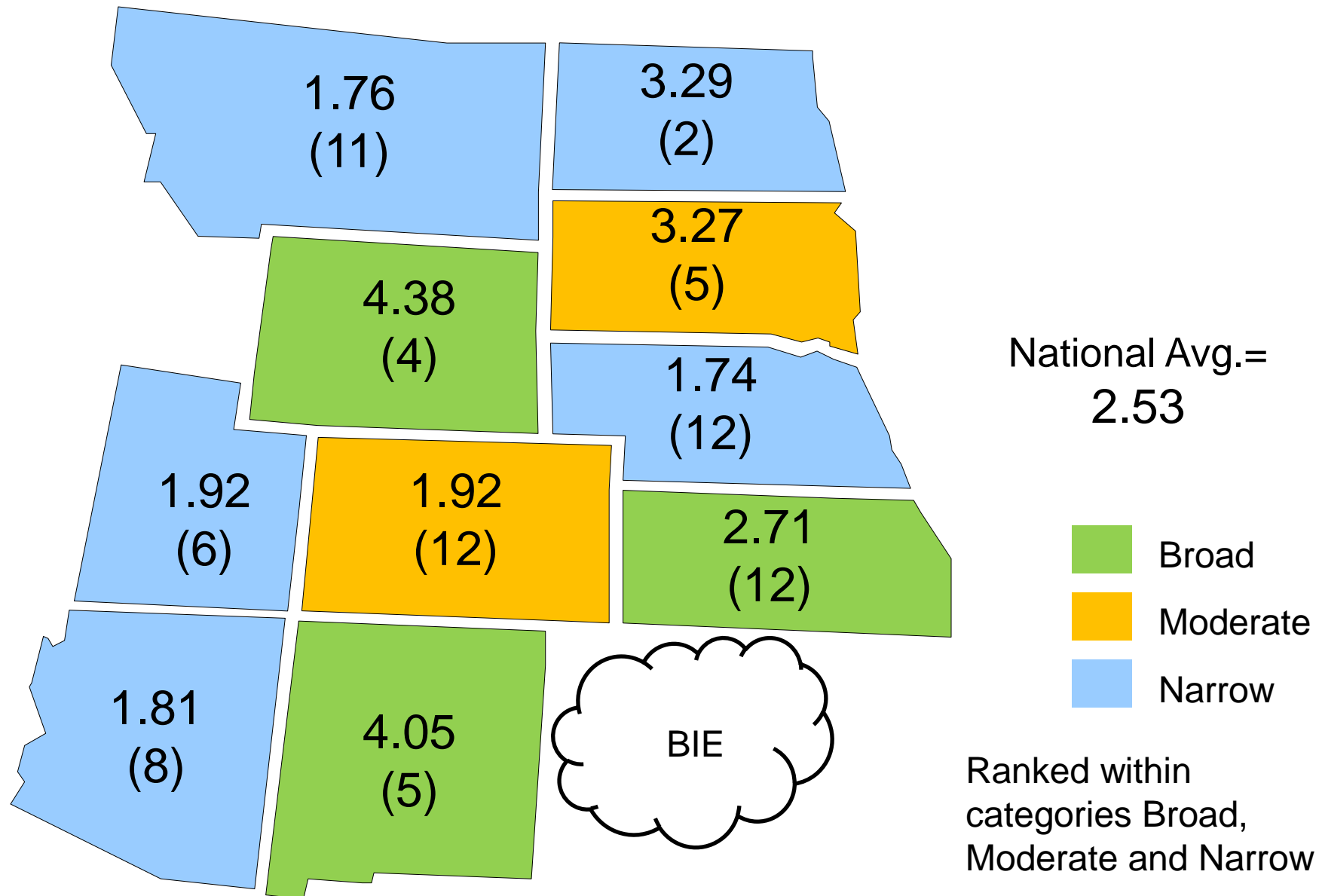

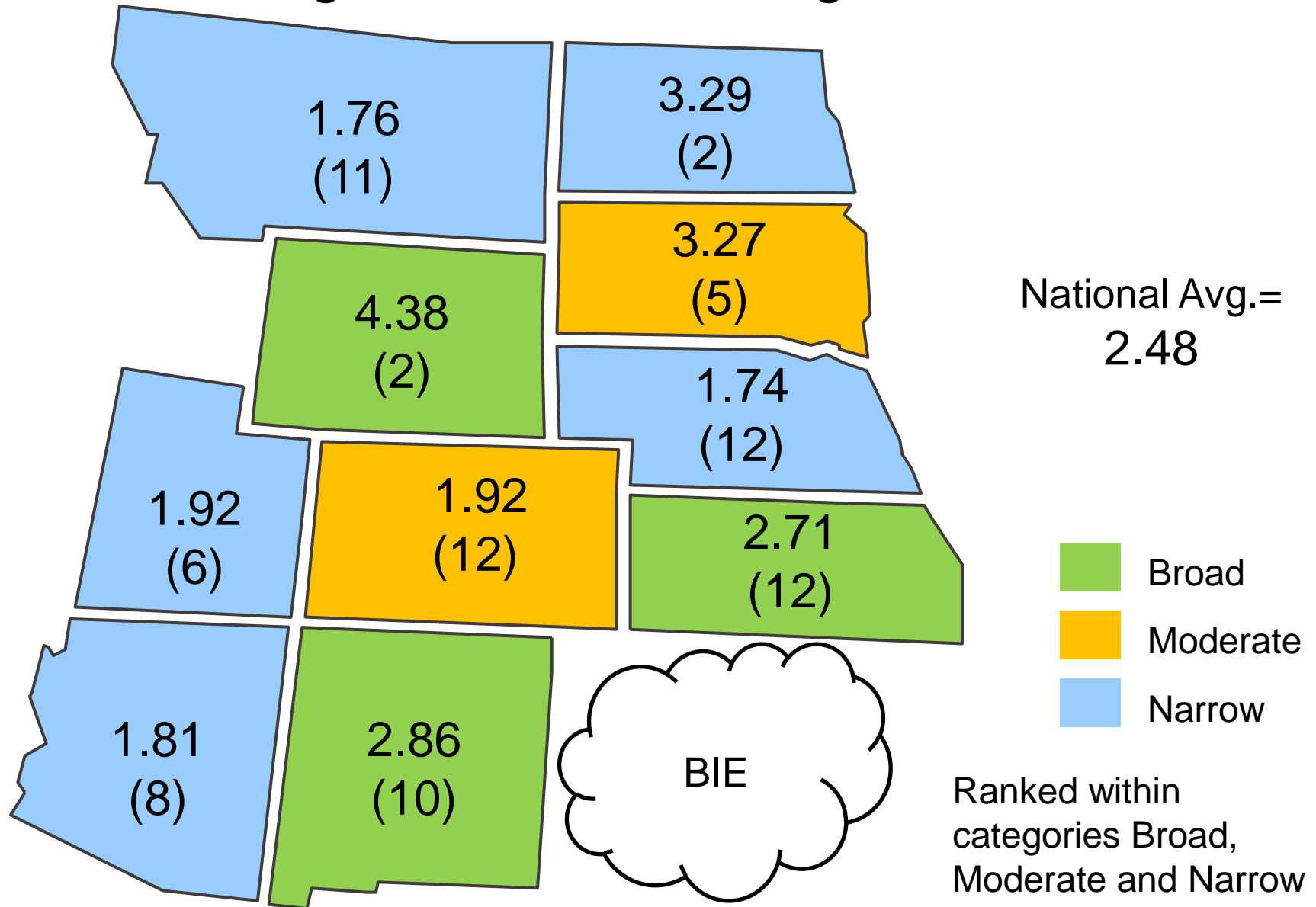

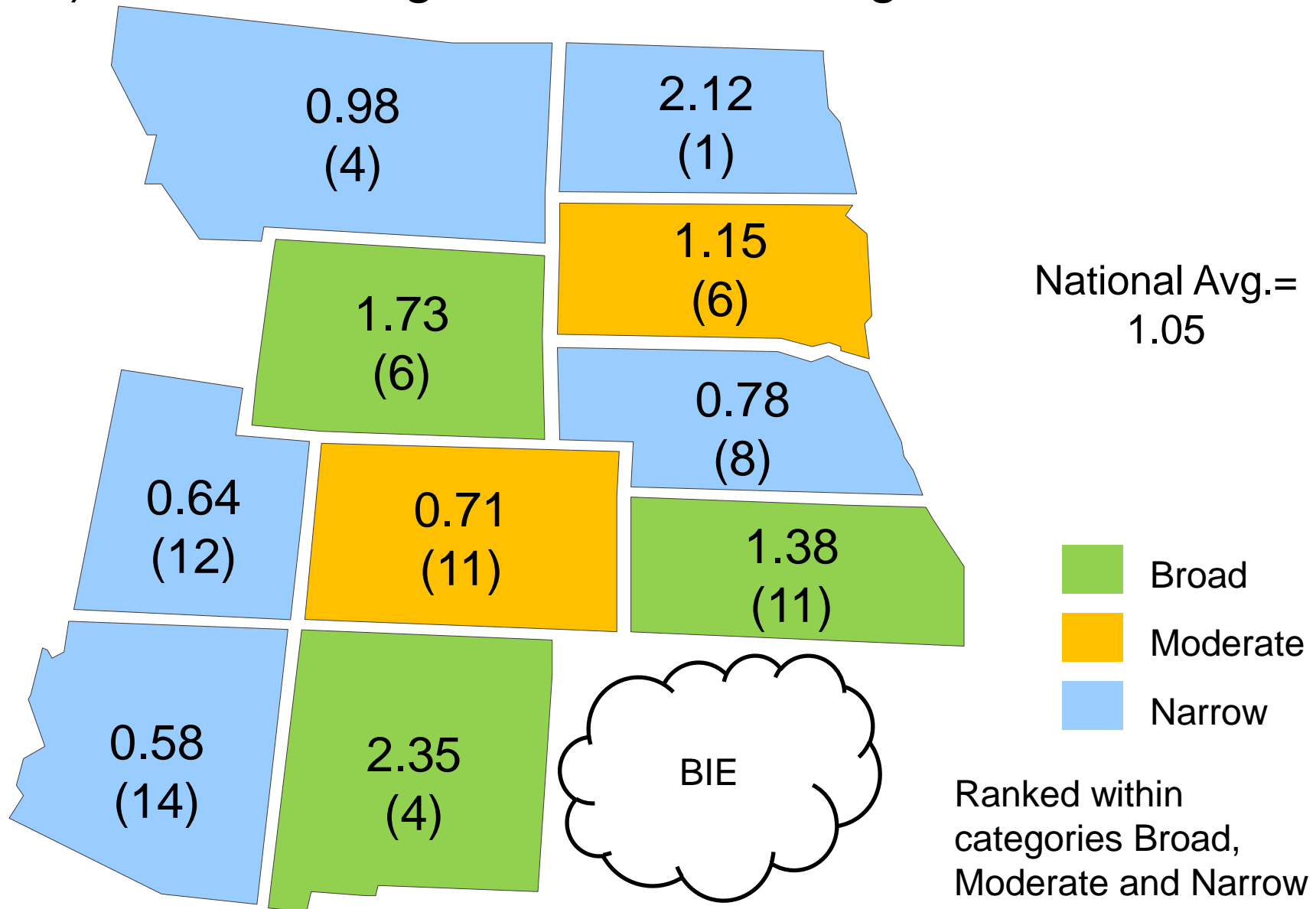
# MPRRC, Percentage of All Children (including At Risk) Under the age of Three receiving services, 2007



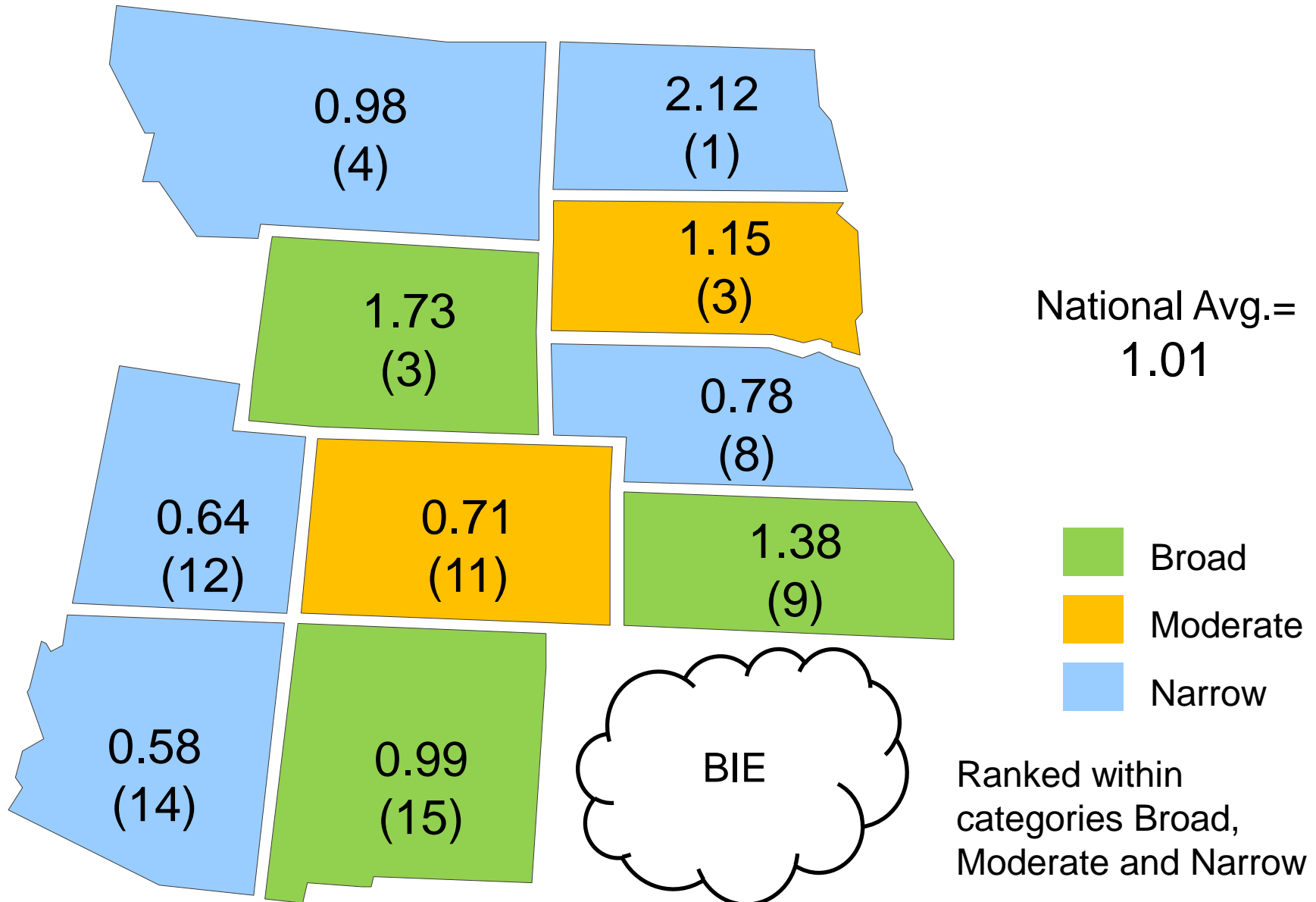
# MPRRC, Percentage of All Children (without At Risk) Under the age of Three receiving services, 2007



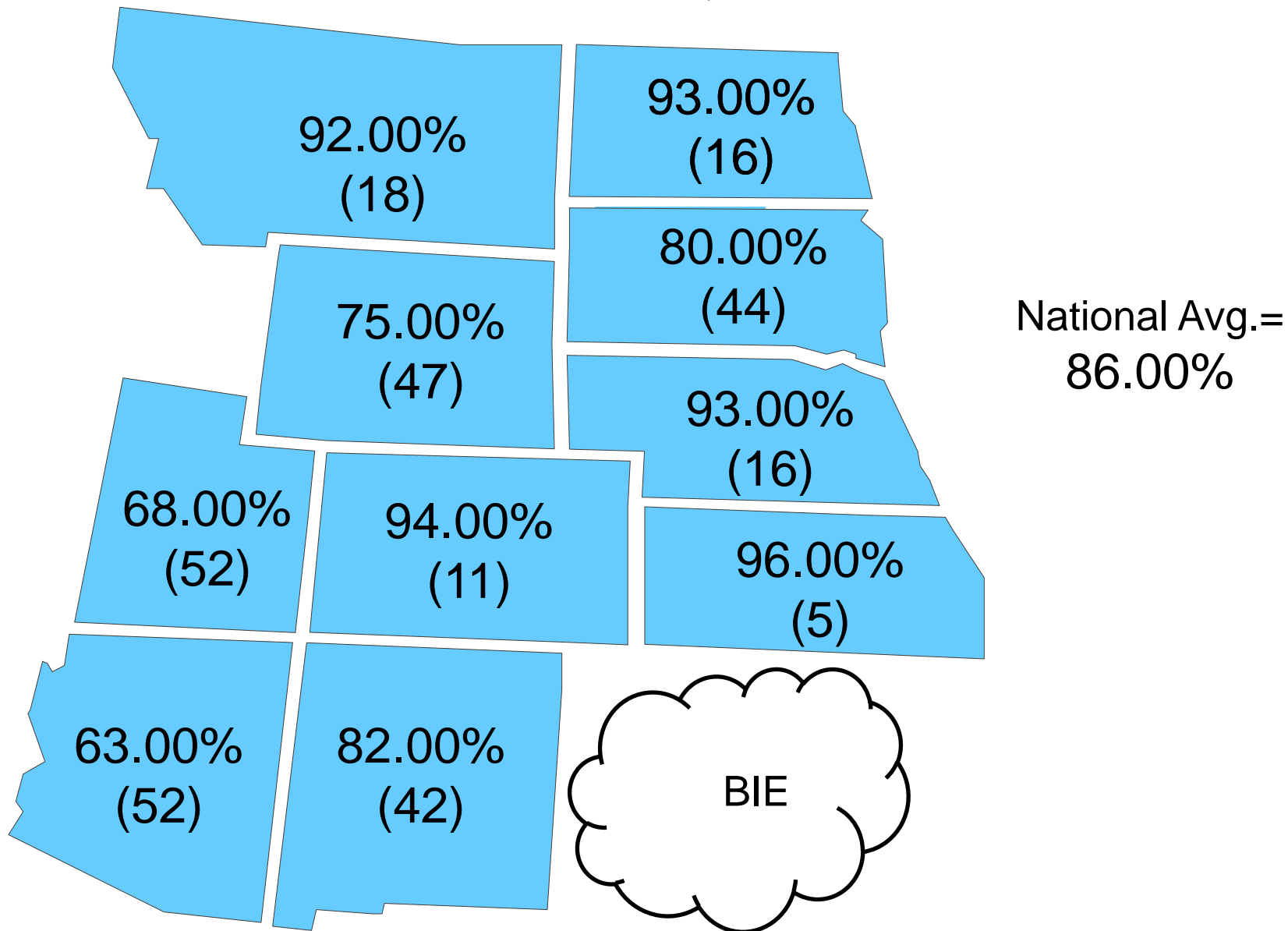
# MPRRRC, Percentage of All Children (including At Risk) Under the age of One receiving services, 2007



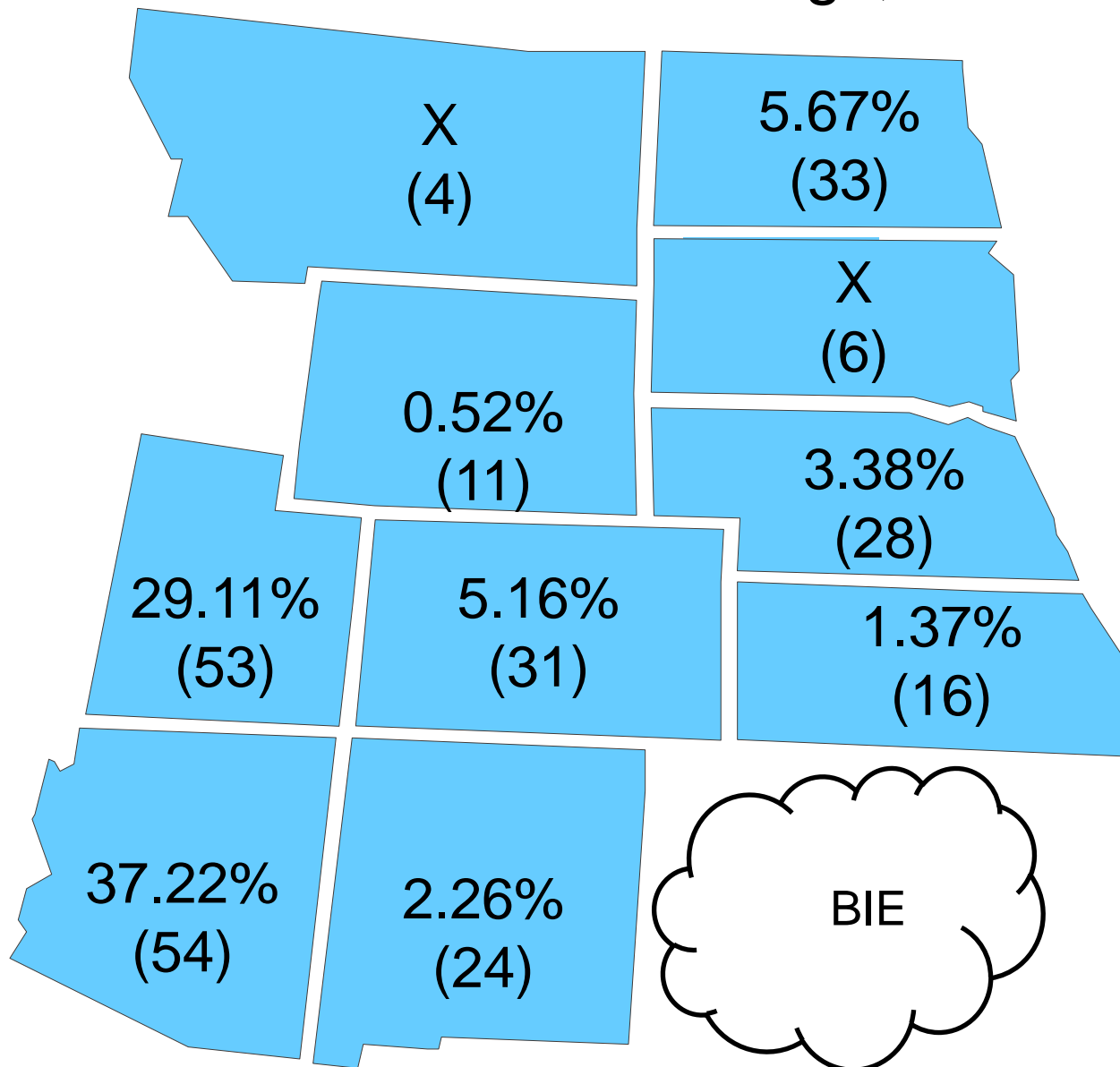
# MPRRC, Percentage of All Children (without At Risk) Under the age of One receiving services, 2007
